Supply List for the Colored Pencil and Water Soluble Graphite Pencil Class

Watercolor colored pencils, Derwent recommended. The largest set you can afford or individual colors can be purchased from open stock from Blick's art supply on-line.

The Derwent watercolor pencils can be used both wet and dry so will work well for the applications we are going to use.

Colored pencil pencil sharpener.

Vanish eraser (available in class) and a kneadable eraser.

Soft make-up brush to brush away the eraser and pencil crumbs.

VISA paper towels.

Fine nib watercolor pen. Blick or Hobby Lobby

Copyright free reference photo of an animal or flower. There are several sights on the internet or use one of your own. I will have some.

Sheet of glassine to protect art from oil on your hand.

Clipboard, gatorboard, plexiglass, or masonite for support for your drawing.

Later you will need water soluble graphite pencils and a sheet of printmaking paper.
