## ICL now has coin rolling equipment and supplies for checkout

Why do U.S coins seem to be in short supply? Business and bank closures associated with the COVID-19 pandemic have significantly disrupted the supply chain and normal circulation patterns for U.S coins.

As the economy recovers and businesses reopen, more coins will flow back into retail and banking channels and eventually into the Federal Reserve, which should allow for the rebuilding of coin inventories.

Ignacio Community Library now has supplies to help you cash in on your piggy bank put coins back in circulation. You can check-out coin tubes and coin wrappers to make the job easier. This should help out patrons as the bank requires coins to be rolled for deposit Ask for the coin tubes at the service desk.

"Candy Corn has been around for more than a century. George Renninger of the Wunderlee Candy Company invented it in the 1880's, according to the National Confectioners Association. Perhaps because its look was reminiscent of farm life, it caught on with city folk nostalgic for a rural past. At any rate, it's tri-colored look was revolutionary for the candy industry at the time. The Goelitz Candy Company started making candy corn in in 1900 and still makes it today, although the company name has changed to the Jelly Belly Candy Company.


