This is a Friends of the Library fundraiser, the proceeds will be put towards helping your library!

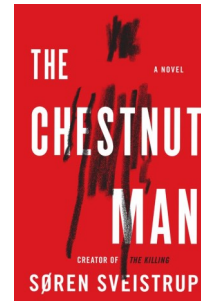
Local art wanted!

and talking about it!

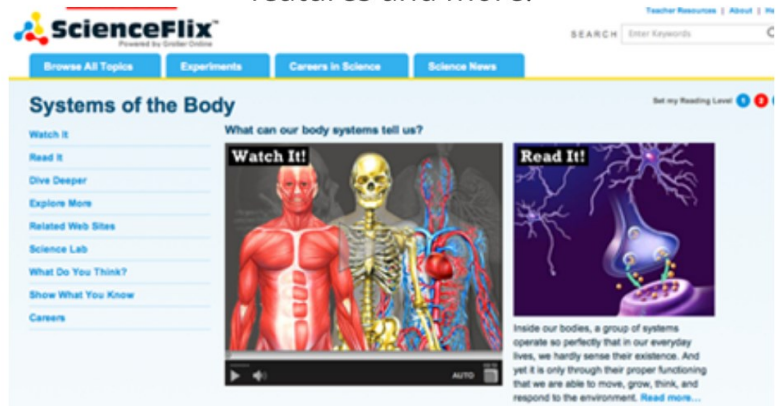

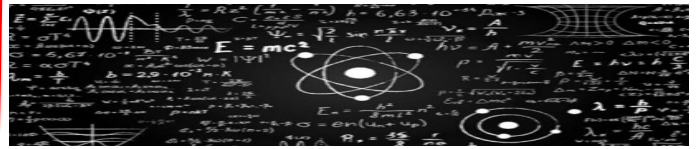
